She said that efficient fight against corruption requires creation of laws that will not be selective and occasionally applied but rather they will have good mechanisms for the protection of institutions the are applying them. Mrs. Barac estimate that is possible to achieve improvements in the fight against corruption, better laws, independence, autonomous and responsible judiciary i.e. the institution that could look straight into the eyes the problem of the corruption.

Content	<p>Corruption in executive power economy and judiciary is the great obstacle in development of social and political stability of Serbia and Montenegro, as well as in many other countries in the region and worldwide. For the Government representatives the fight against corruption is unanimously proclaimed as the one of the priorities. Council for the Fight against Corruption supported by the Embassy of Switzerland, and Bazel Institute on Governance have organised anticorruption days, that are going on today and tomorrow.</p> <p>The aim is to tighten application of international laws in the fields of bribes, money laundering and organised crime in Serbia. According to the Head of the Anti-Corruption Council, Verica Barać, the laws that have passed up to now, are applying selectively and according to the needs. She stated that for all these years we haven't got the answer to the one of the most important questions.</p> <p>The expectation of citizen were betrayed after the changes in 2000, as there was not reached consensus of political actors to pass new Constitution of Serbia, that would be the basis of new democratic and modern state.</p> <p>In Switzerland is present corruption too but not so much as in Serbia, said Ambassador of Switzerland in Serbia and Montenegro Vilhem Meir. The aim of two days seminar is to raise awareness about corruption and money laundering and about their different consequences, as well as about possible legal medicines, as to help the Council to solve that problem.</p>
